



Children's Home Society of Florida is the only organization in the nation to develop the innovative solution – CaseAIM™ – to address lengthy stays in foster care. By addressing the root causes of lengthy stays – case manager turnover – CHS is reshaping the future for children and families involved in the foster care system.

An independent study completed by the Florida Institute for Child Welfare concluded that children experience better outcomes with CaseAIM. Among the findings:

Children spend nearly **100 FEWER DAYS** in foster care.



Children are more likely to safely return home or find stability through adoption within 12 months.

61% of children working with CaseAIM exited foster care within 12 months compared to 45 percent of those not using CaseAIM.

Children experience fewer placement moves.

2.8 MOVES

Children working with CaseAIM moved homes 2.8 times; those not using CaseAIM moved 3.4 times.

Children experience more stability with their case managers.

With CaseAIM, children experienced fewer case manager turnover events, leading to better relationships and deeper trust.
