Andry Sweet has more than three decades of experience in child welfare and behavioral health, and specializes in system improvements designed to provide comprehensive and innovative services to Florida's children and families. She previously served as COO where she oversaw CHS contract management, systems evaluations and process improvement. Sweet leads daily organizational operations including leadership and direction of the executive management team.

Sweet joined CHS' executive team as an executive director in 2000. She has since served as vice president of operations, vice president of innovation and quality management, chief strategy officer, chief of staff, chief administrative officer and COO.

In the early 2000s, Sweet managed the transition of child welfare from government to the private sector. More recently, she has led innovative work at CHS, including the development and replication of Community Partnership Schools in Florida, integrated health care pilots with Medicaid HMOs and CaseAIM™ to improve child welfare outcomes. She has held leadership positions for a variety of community boards, including the Heart of Florida United Way Council of Agency Executives Steering Committee, the Children's Cabinet of Seminole County Executive Committee and the Children's Cabinet of Orange County; she is currently the chair of the Evans Community School Cabinet.
